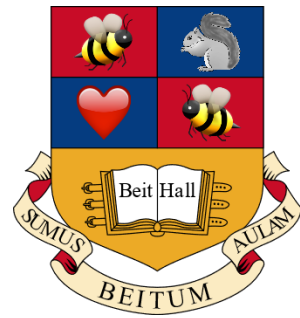
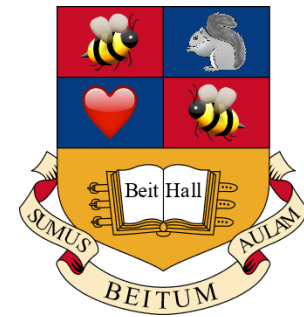


Beit Hall: Introduction



Brief History of Beit Hall



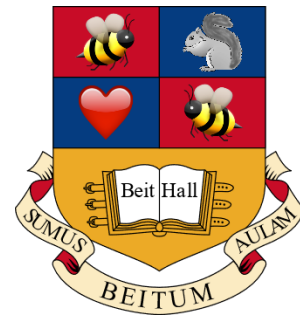
- Building of Beit Hall funded by Sir Otto Beit director of the governing body of Imperial College 1912-1930.
- Initially it was a faculty building housing Biology and later converted to a student Hall.
- Renovated to its present state in 2001.
- Currently one of the largest Halls of Imperial College providing self-catering accommodation to 340 students.

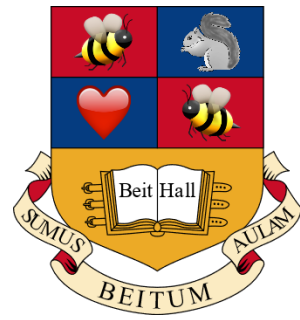

Locations of Housekeeping and Security Offices

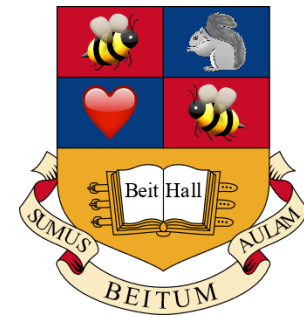

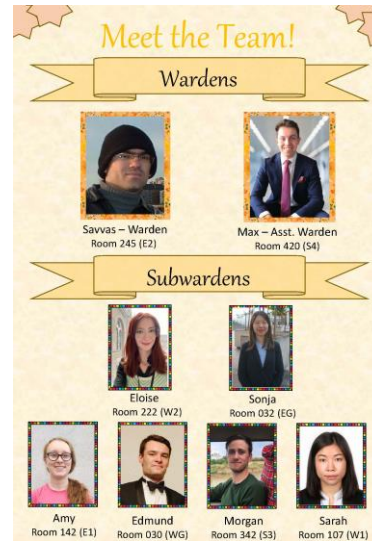
Locations of entrances to Beit Hall

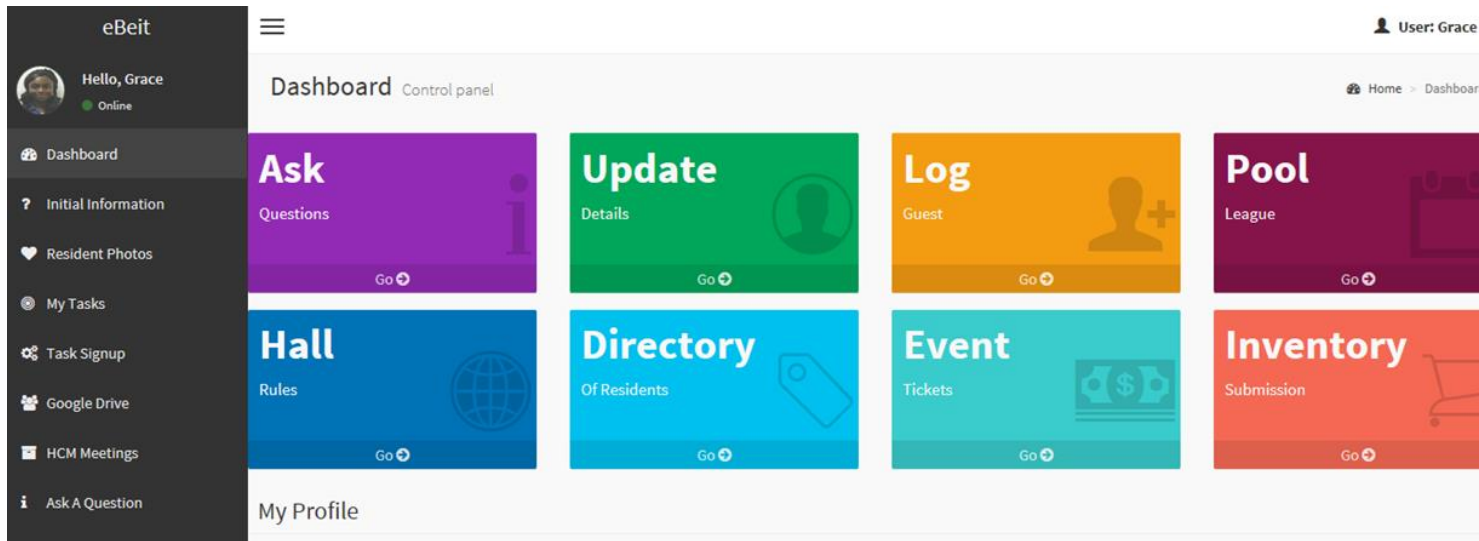
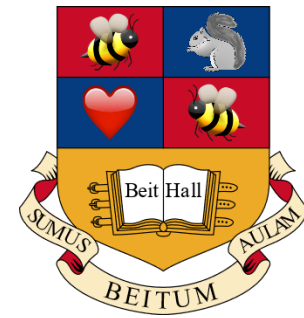
Hall Rules

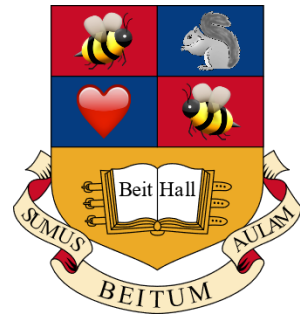


Go-to place for all things Beit throughout the year!

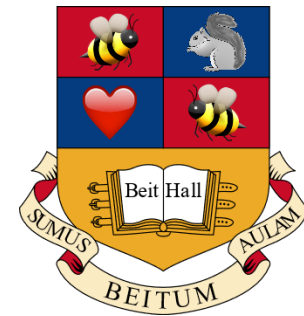
- Quick and easy to log overnight guests, e.g. when friends come to visit

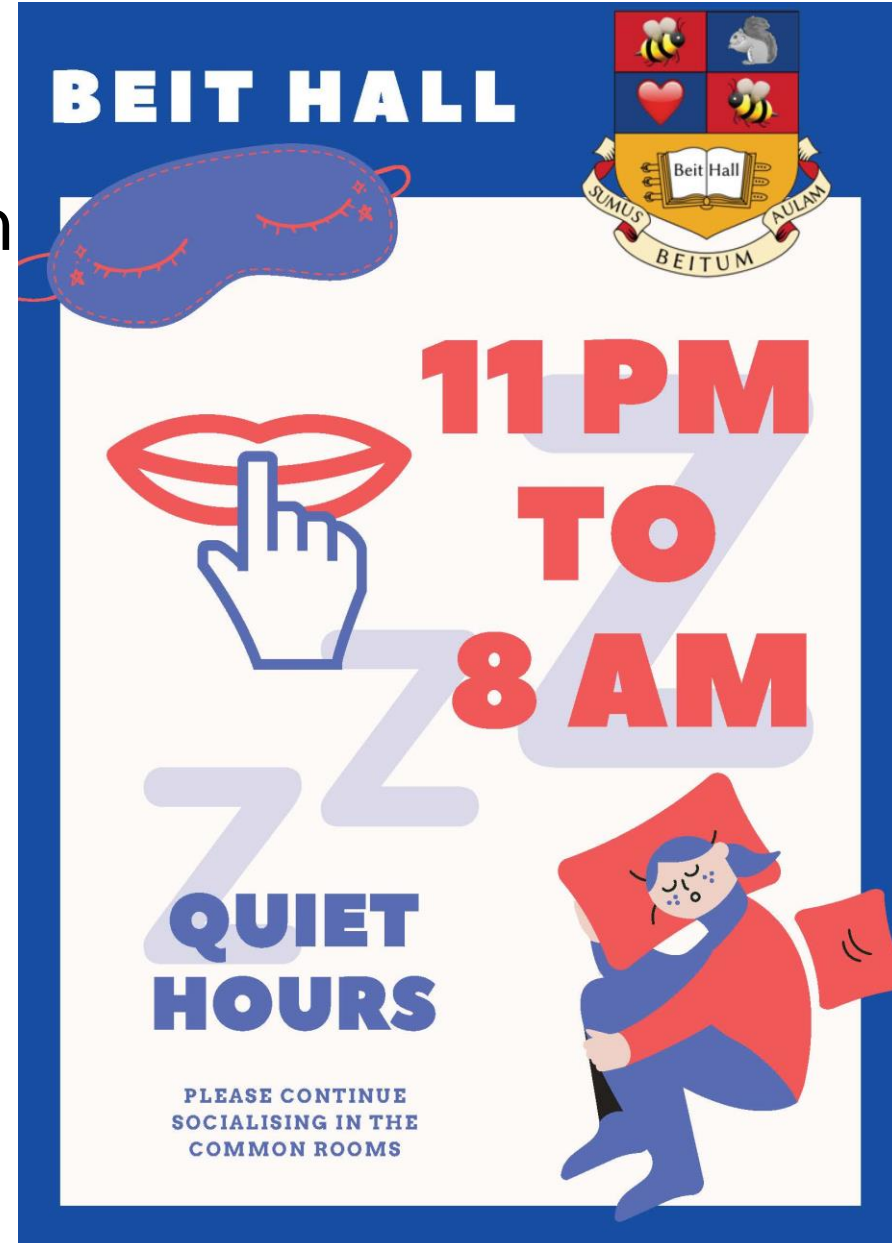

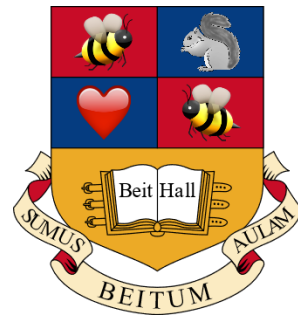

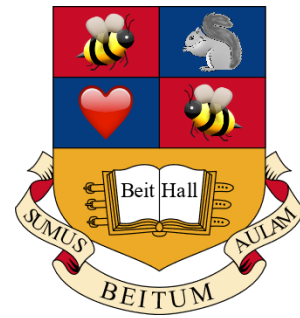

Drugs

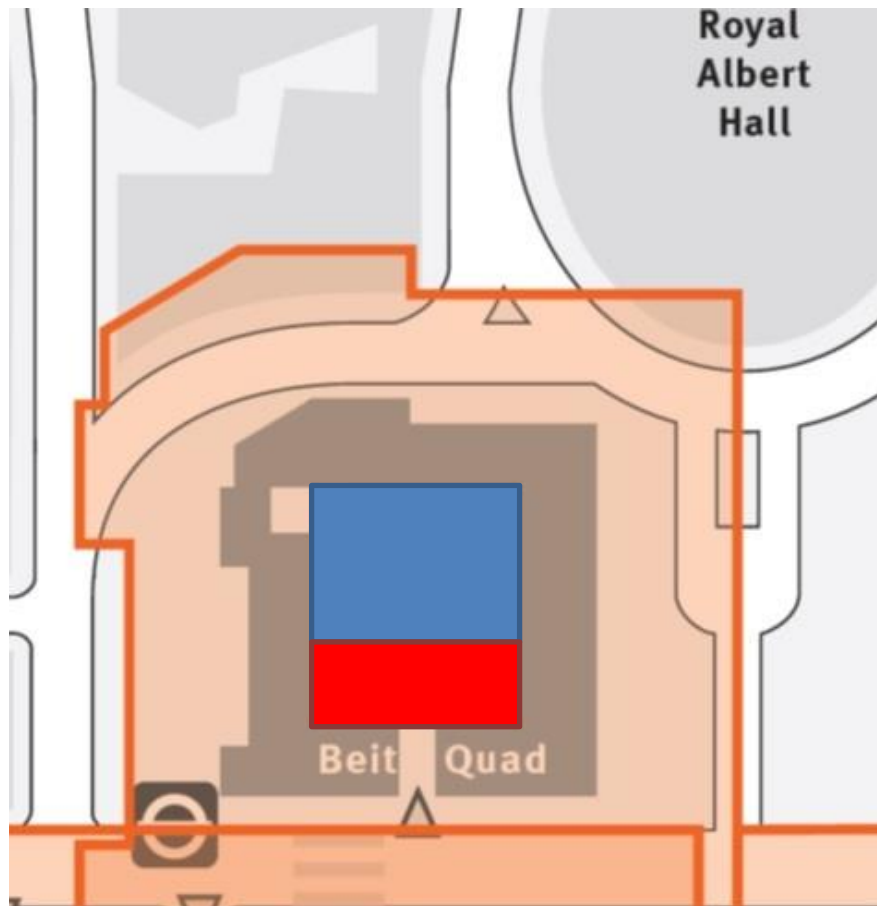
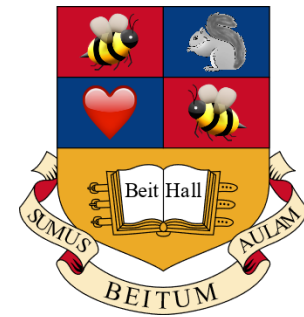


- **No illegal drugs**. The College has a zero tolerance policy on drug use and possession

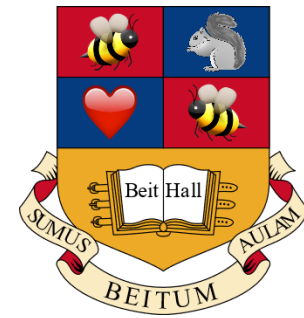

Smoking



- Imperial's smoke-free policy applies to **College land and within 20 metres of College land for Imperial's community**
- In the Quad smoking may be allowed past the barriers on ticketed events on Wednesdays and Fridays only
- **No Smoking at all times 5 metres from the South side of the Hall**
- No vaping, e-cigarettes in Hall

Health and Safety issues



Fire alarms

- Loud high-pitched siren,
- Every resident must evacuate **immediately**
- Use nearest exit, gather in Beit Quad
- Do not use the lift
- Do not re-enter the building until told to do so

Also

- Let a warden know if you have difficulty hearing the alarm or evacuating the building quickly
- Find out today where your nearest exits are

Health and Safety issues



Do not leave kitchen doors open !

Do not leave the kitchen oven/stove on, unattended !

FIRE ALARMS



Kitchens have heat detectors

Corridors have smoke detectors

Leaving the kitchen door open will set off the smoke alarm, leading to unnecessary evacuation of the building

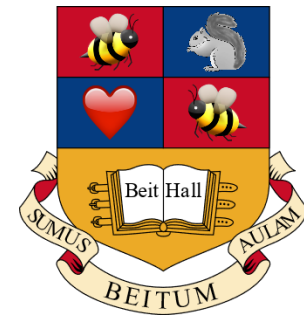
Never prop kitchen and corridor doors open

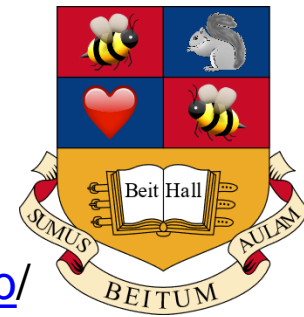

Self-isolating in halls

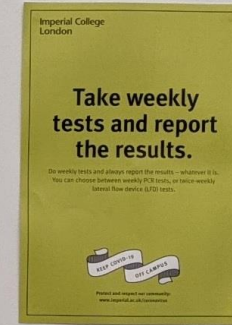
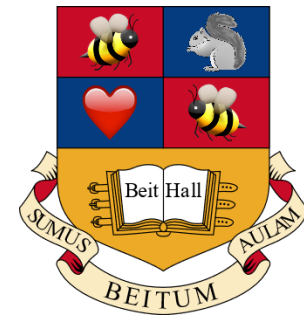
There may be times whilst staying in halls that you will need to self-isolate. If you do need to self-isolate, we're here to support you.

When will I need to self-isolate?

Depending on the reason for your need to self-isolate there are different procedures you should follow:

Reason for self-isolation	What will happen
You feel unwell with COVID-19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Follow the instructions on the CCTHub webpage, including reporting your status on MyImperialYou must remain in your room under all circumstances (except emergencies) for 10 days starting the day after the onset of your symptoms
